Pir Mehr Ali Shah Arid Agriculture University Rawalpindi (PMAS-AAUR) organized a field workshop, "Handing over and Demonstration of Seed Grader to Growers Group" at District Attock, under ACIAR Pulses Project-04. The main objective of the workshop was to hand over a seed grader for Chickpea and Groundnut crop to the farmers group, its demonstration and inauguration of the Village Based Seed System run by the local growers' group. Almost 70 participants (contact growers) from Fateh Jang, Pindighaib and Jand areas participated this event.
